Local Government Information Unit (LGIU) - There has been a global surge in domestic abuse during lockdown restrictions, leading the <u>UN secretary general to call on governments</u> around the world to put in place policies to tackle violence against women and girls and ensure safe refuge for victims. Women's groups and domestic abuse charities have raised concerns that the lockdown restrictions and self-isolation may leave victims trapped with abusers. Abusive behaviour may escalate in response to stresses caused by job loss, financial pressures and frustration about the lockdown restrictions or because perpetrators feel emboldened as abuse is less likely to be noticed or reported. It may be more difficult for victims to seek help discreetly, and options for leaving an abusive situation may be restricted due to the lockdown. Although not all victims of domestic abuse are women, almost a third of women in the UK are estimated to experience abuse during their lifetime and two women a week on average are killed by a current or former partner in England and Wales alone. The issues for councils were covered in more detail in a recent LGIU briefing.

Male Survivor Helpline – please see graphic for use on social media etc attached 0808 800 5005. 1 in 6 men in the UK have been targets of rape and sexual abuse, that's 5 Million Men in the UK. Abusers don't discriminate - abuse can happen to any man of any age, race, class or sexual identity.


