## Safer Cumbria launch Modern Slavery Pathways and Guidance

<u>Modern Slavery Pathways & Guidance</u> developed in consultation with Cumbria Safeguarding Adults (CSAB) and Cumbria Safeguarding Children's Partnership (CSCP). The guidance will assist and support partners, charities and persons who may come into contact with a possible victim of Modern Slavery or Human Trafficking. Modern Slavery is a heinous crime which is often hidden from sight.

This Guidance will offer the reader an overview of the indicators of Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking and will advise them on the next steps to take to support, report and help a victim of Modern Slavery. The Guidance also gives an overview of the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) process and helps to provide First Responders with the information they will need to help refer a victim into the NRM.

Alongside the Modern Slavery Pathways and Guidance, Safer Cumbria now have leaflets available for all to use which will help support victims of Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking understand the National Referral Mechanism. These leaflets have been created in several languages, so it is easier for the victim to understand the information.
