Safety Net has extra capacity to support people who have experienced trauma

Safety Net is a free service supporting the recovery of adults and children in Cumbria who have experienced rape, exploitation, domestic and sexual abuse. After many months of experiencing limited capacity as a direct result of Covid, its Trauma Informed Practitioners have additional capacity for adults and children who are no longer experiencing abuse, but may be struggling to manage on a day to day basis. The team can provide support on a range of practical issues as well as providing advice on managing symptoms, mindfulness, self-care and relaxation.
